1: How many mutations are possible for the following operators:

- Relational Operator Replacement
- Arithmetic Operator Replacement

2: Apply the relational operator replacement operation to statement 4 of the method, and design a test case that would kill that mutant.

3: Design an equivalent mutant that no test case can detect. You may apply up to three mutation operators.

4: Design a valid, but useless mutant. You may apply up to three mutation operators.
